The exterior of this Citation V is been very well cared for with a tasteful livery of Matterhorn White with Bristol Blue and Castle Tan Metallic accent striping performed by Murmer Aircraft Painting. The aircraft has the most desirable nine (9) passenger configuration with a forward two-place belted divan, center four-place club with fully reclining and laterally tracking seats, and two forward facing rear captain's chairs. The fully enclosed lavatory includes a flushing belted lavatory seat and vanity with sink. Long lasting LED lights have replaced the original bulbs, and a forward RosenView VX system has been installed including Bulkhead LCD Screen with Moving Map and DVD player. Cabin connectivity includes Iridium SATCOM with text messaging capability.

The Citation V is one of the most sought after aircraft in today's marketplace due to it combination of low acquisition and operating costs, single-pilot capability, and ease of ownership. It also has the ability to operate into airports that other nine passenger aircraft cannot. Because the aircraft does not match the current owner's mission, he will be seeking a replacement aircraft. A cabin temp indicator and freon air conditioning modification ensure passenger comfort throughout flight, while an LED cabin lighting upgrade with EMTEQ downwash and interior lighting, and AVTEC LED passenger reading lights provide ideal conditions for work or entertainment.

Entertainment and business functionality provided by 115v cabin inverter and outlets, iPod docking station, XM Satellite radio, cabin speaker amplifier, Iridium ST-3100 SATCOM with cabin handset, and RosenView VX Moving Map with bulkhead monitor.
